Where: The Plaza Hotel, 3253 N. Nimitz Hwy, Honolulu Hawai'i. Limited neighbor island travel support available.

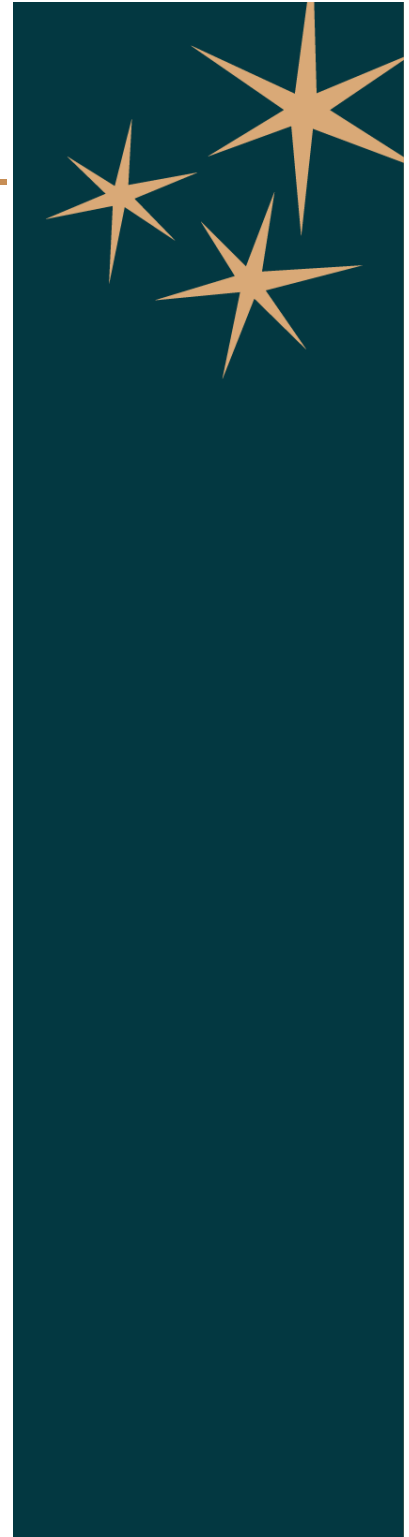
When: Thursday evening, November 4 and all day Friday, November 5
